


# UNDERGROUND MINE TOURS

Thousands of years ago, prehistoric miners discovered pure copper in the rock outcrops of Adventure Bluff. They mined these outcrops for centuries and then vanished, leaving behind primitive tools, countless mining pits and more questions than answers. These ancient workings were later discovered by mid-1800's prospectors and became the locations for the numerous shafts and miles of tunnels excavated to become the Adventure Mine.
