

With an average descent of 14 feet per mile, the Sturgeon River is the fastest river in Michigan's Lower Peninsulal Not whitewater, but exciting and challenging with its quick current, leaning trees, numerous sharp turns, and narrow passages. The current does most of the work, but it's up to you and your partner(s) to maneuver your watercraft down the stream. The crystal-clear, spring fed water has an average depth of 3-4 feet and winds its way through beautiful state forest. We offer various types of equipment and on different sections of the river, something to please every skill and adventure level! All River Trips Include: U.S. Coast Guard Approved & Safety-Inspected Equipment, Paddles, Lifejackets, Shuttle Service to the Put-In, & Maps.
