## GROUP LESSONS

### TOTEM PARK LEARNING AREA

Totem Park covers nearly two acres and includes two Wonder Carpet™ surface lifts. Wonder Carpets™ are conveyor belts built into the snow for beginners to stand on as they're gently transported uphill. Skiers and snowboarders enjoy a comfortable ride to the top and have plenty of room to practice their turns on this terrain area totally dedicated to beginners. Skiers and riders are welcome in Totem Park even when not enrolled in lessons.

#### LEARN-TO-SKI I

Learn the basic techniques for gliding, turning and stopping. This lesson takes advantage of the short shaped skis that speed up the learning process for beginners. Participants must use Crystal's beginner-specific rental equipment. For first-timers only, ages 13 and up.

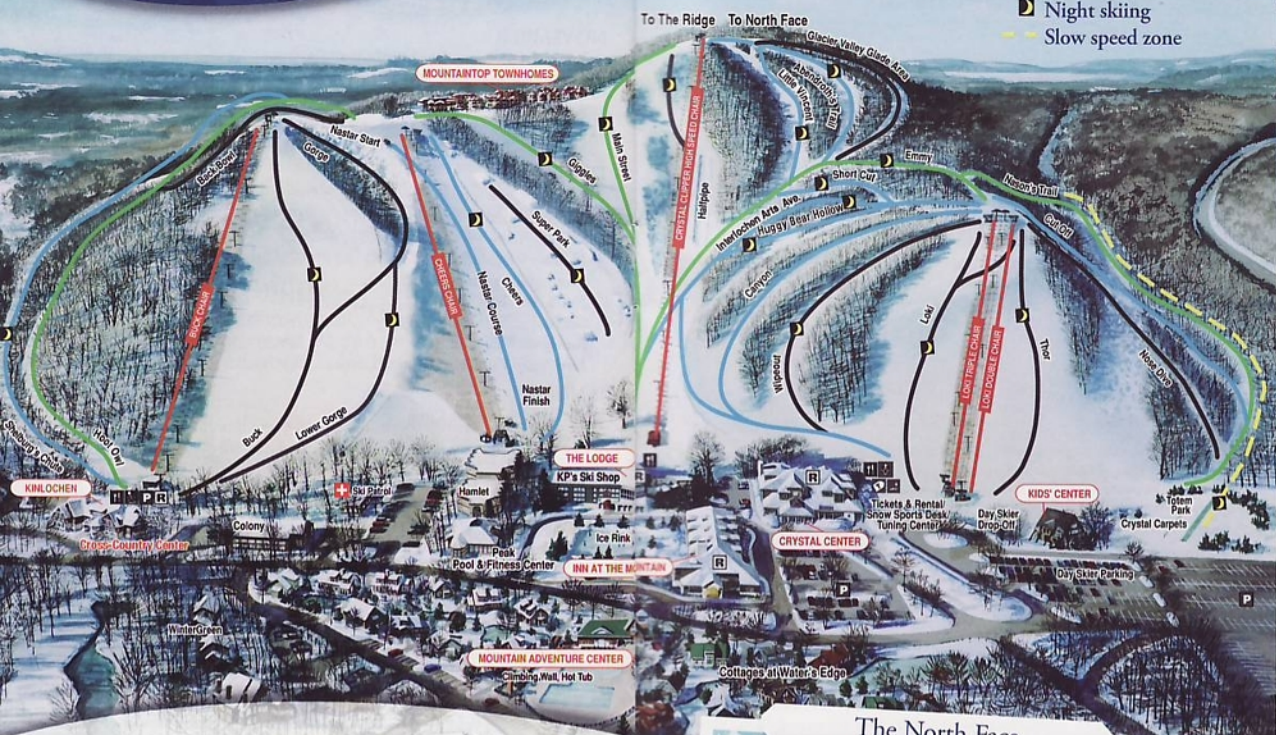

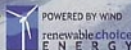
